Visitor Guidelines

Thank you for observing the following visitor guidelines:

- Please enter through the Patient Entrance (South Lobby).
- Visitors must be at least 18 years of age.
- All visitors will be screened for symptoms of illness and temperature upon entry. Visitors who are ill and/or have a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to visit or remain in the Medical Center.

- All visitors will be issued a Visitor Pass. Please place it on your clothing so it is visible to our staff.
- All visitors' names and contact numbers will be recorded prior to being directed to the appropriate patient care unit.
- All visitors must wear a mask throughout their visit in the medical center. If a mask is needed, one can be provided.
- Please practice social distancing in all areas of the Medical Center, including the patient's room.
- Visitors must remain in the patient's room during the visit.
- No food and drink is permitted in any patient's room.

Visitors who are able to comply with these guidelines, are welcome to visit during regular visiting hours.

Exclusions

Visitors are not permitted under the following circumstances:

- For inpatients who are in isolation
- Surgical Services
- Outpatient Services
- For patients in the Emergency Room
- Anyone who has travelled to or from a State on the NJ Travel Advisory List within the last 14 days
